The Manpower Center assured us they would let us know one way or another if the shipmate was located, deceased, or unable to find in the Navy Department system. The cost for each name submitted was \$3.50 per name. Since we had the money we submitted all lost CAIMAN Shipmates E-5 and above. We should hear from NAVPERSCOM this next month the outcome of our request. Bryan Minnegrode has discovered a new mission for the CAIMAN.
